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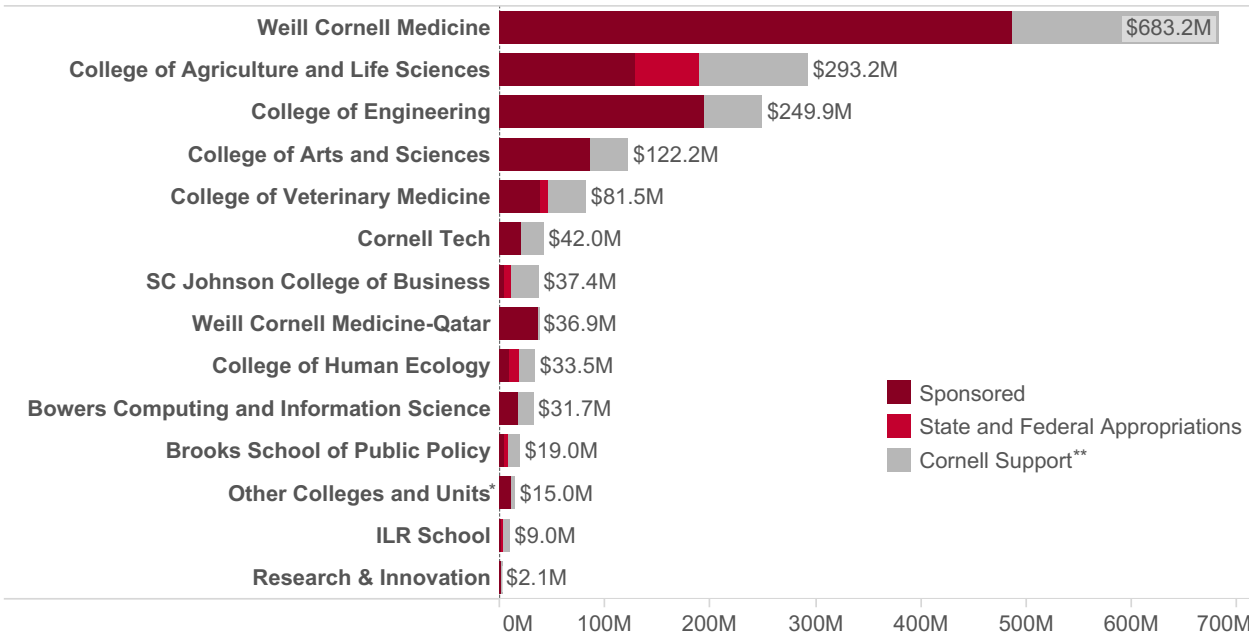

For the purposes of this report, **Organized Research** represents research efforts funded by sponsored programs, federal and New York state appropriations, and internal solicitations, including formal cost sharing. **Departmental Research** represents research-related efforts and activities carried out by Cornell faculty, staff, and students that are mainly funded by gifts and departmental and college-level budgets, including start-up and faculty research accounts. **Total Research** includes both Organized Research and Departmental Research.

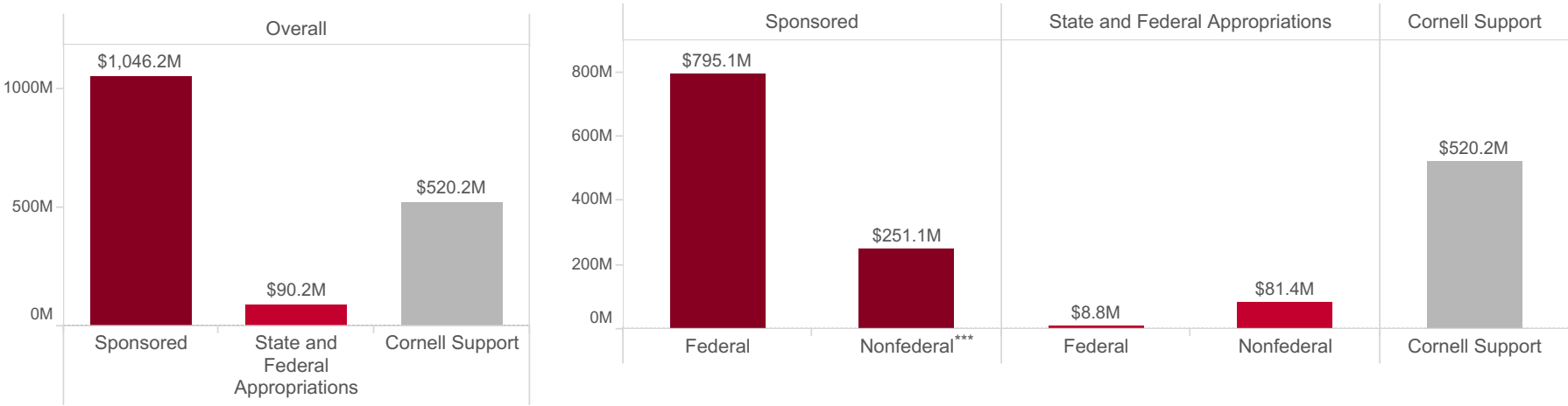
Research & Innovation administered a total of \$158.2M in research expenditures in Fiscal Year 2025 on behalf of the investigators overseeing the research activities of its facilities, labs, institutes, and centers. This report attributes these research expenditures according to the primary college affiliation of the faculty investigators overseeing the expenditures, or, if an investigator is not a faculty member, the primary affiliation of the director of the facility, lab, institute, or center that is administering the funds. Expenditures attributed to Research & Innovation are managed by facilities, labs, institutes, and centers whose director's primary affiliation is with Research & Innovation.

Total Research Expenditures by Funding Source



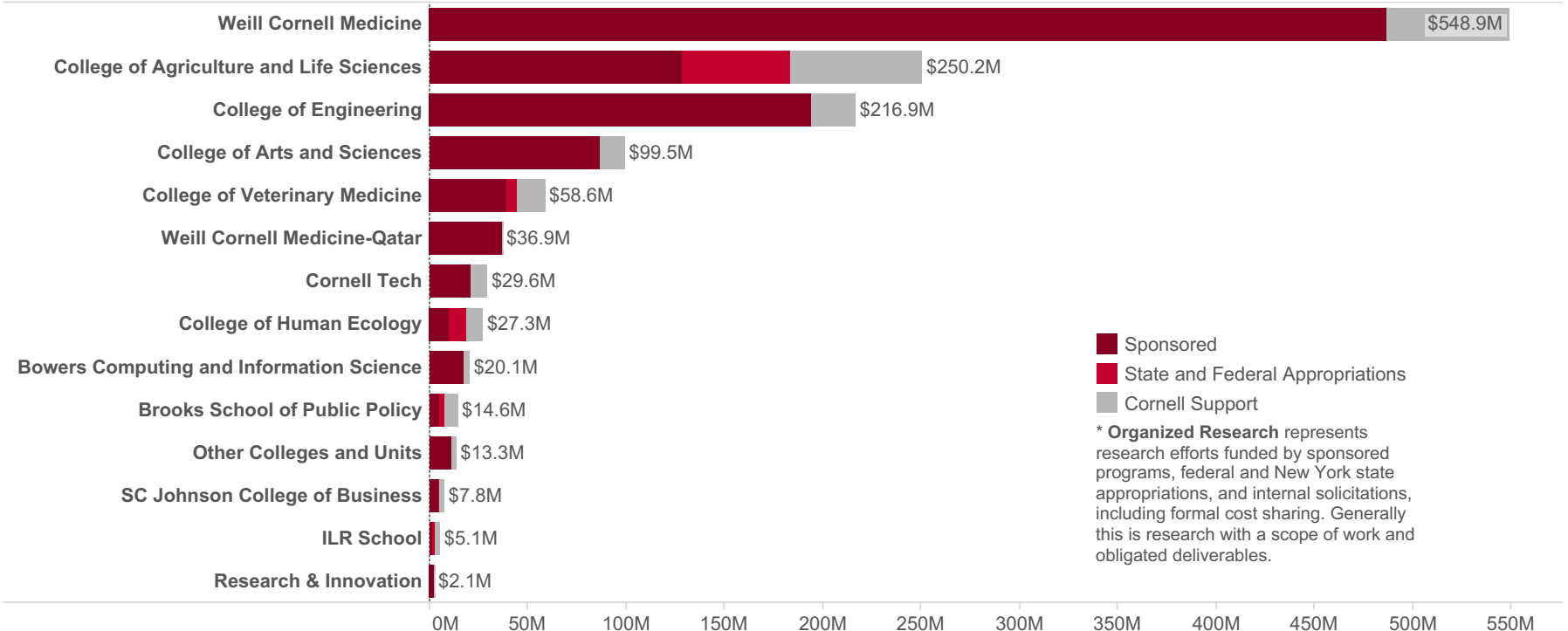

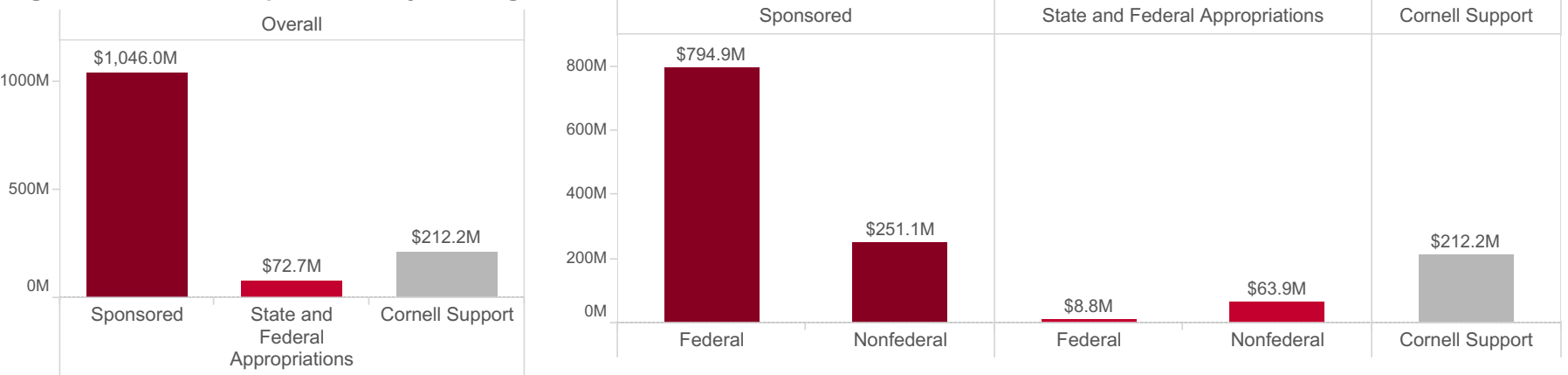

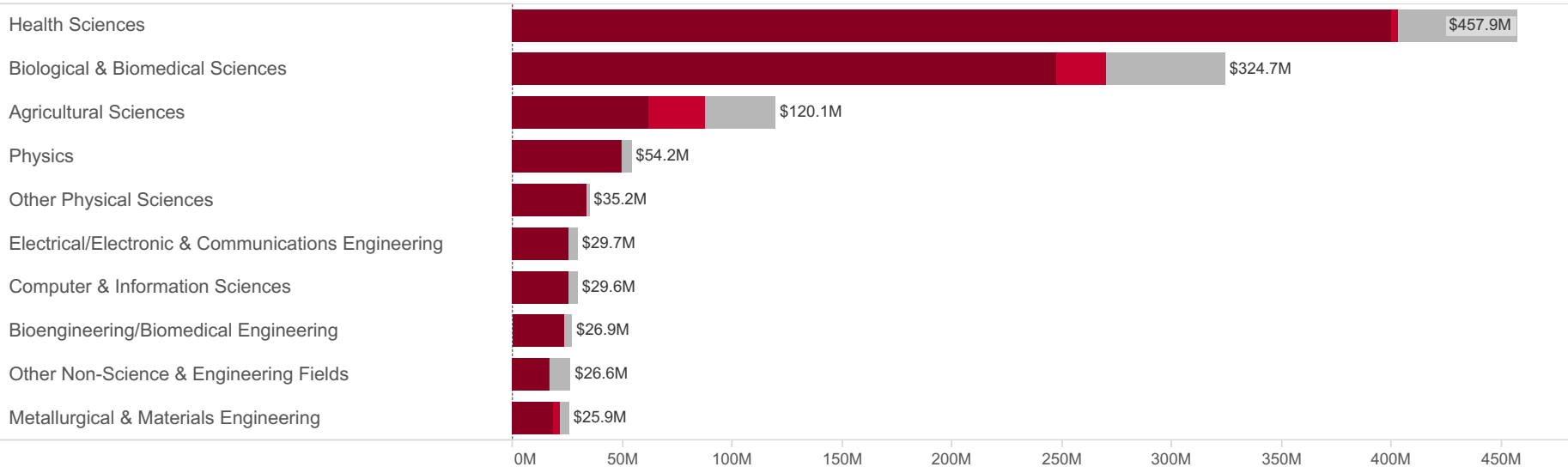

Top 10 Disciplines by Organized Research Expenditures



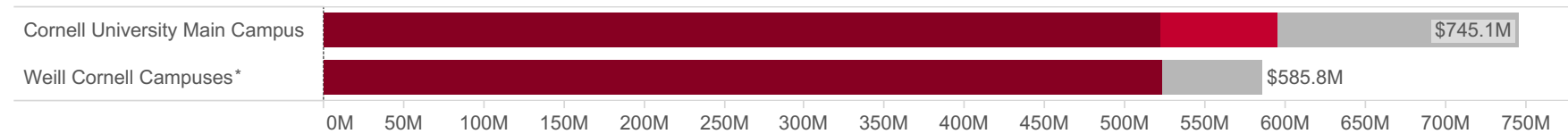

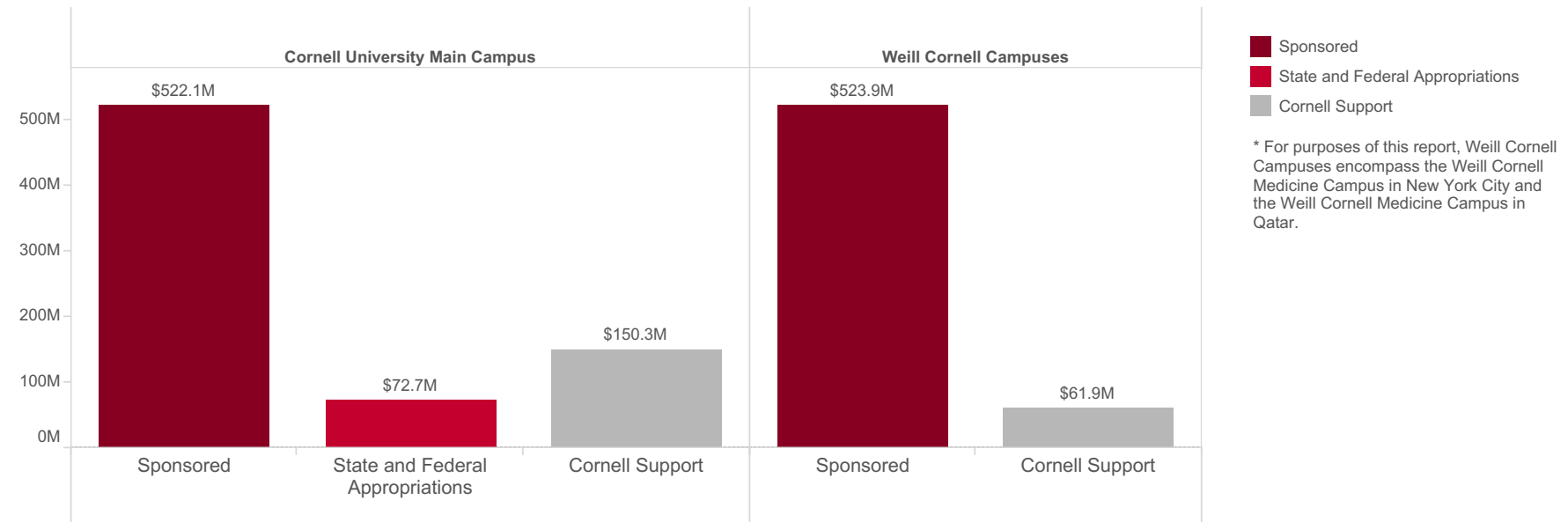

Organized Research Expenditures by Campus and Funding Source



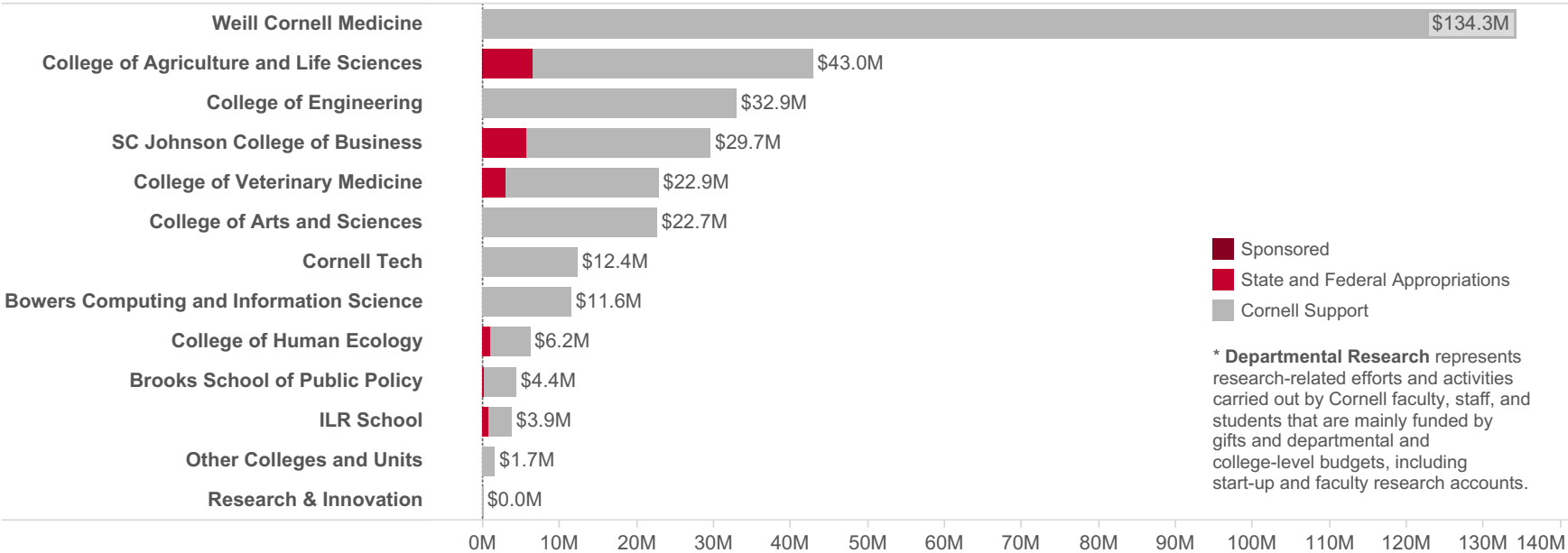

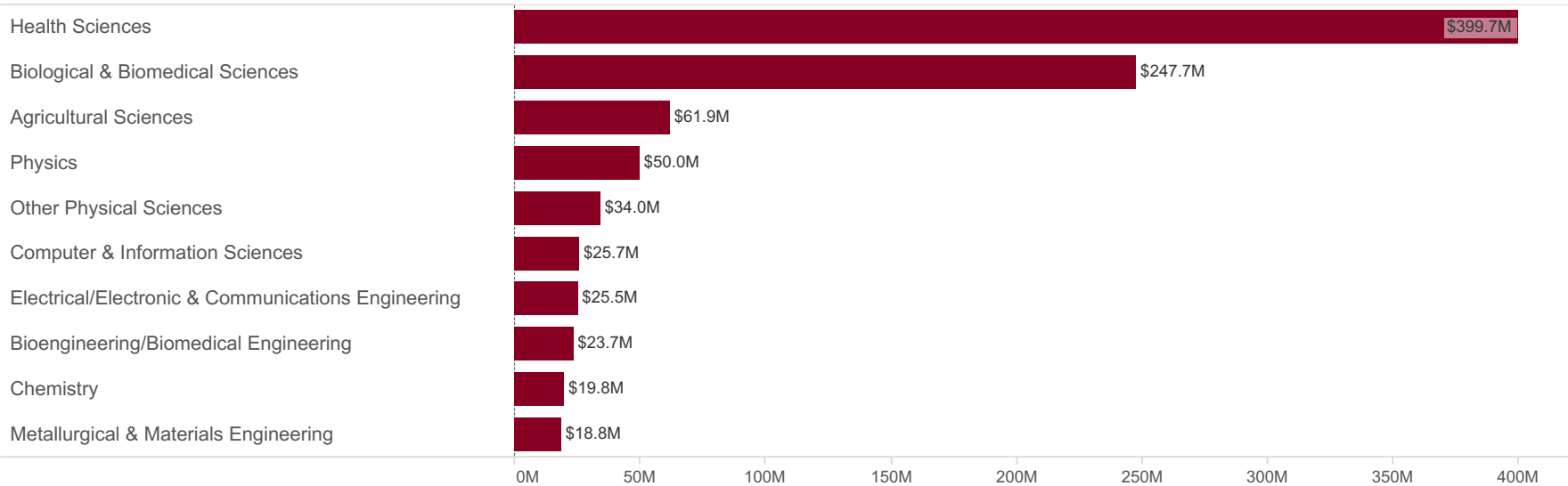

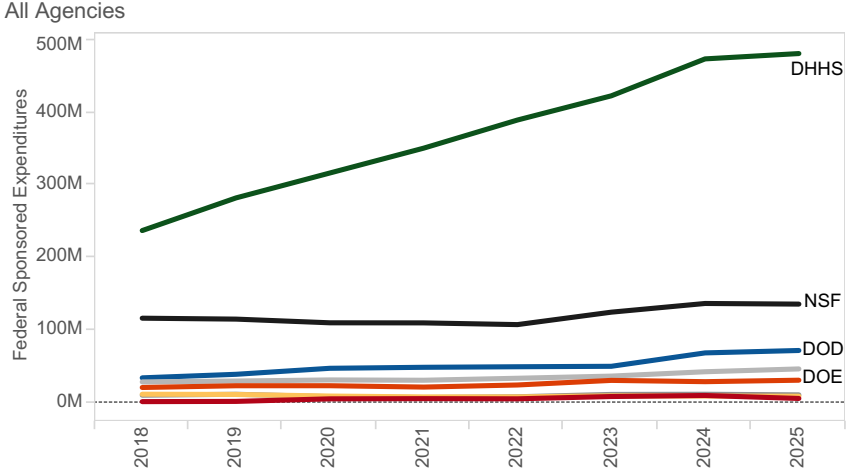
Federal Sponsored Expenditures - Composition by Agency



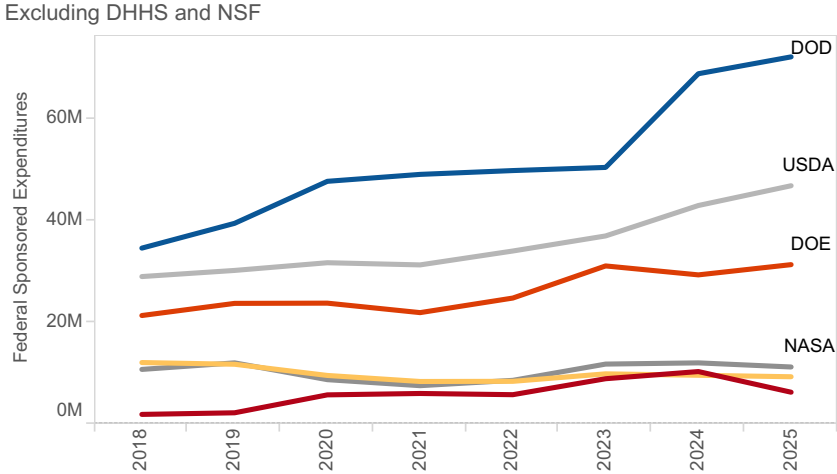

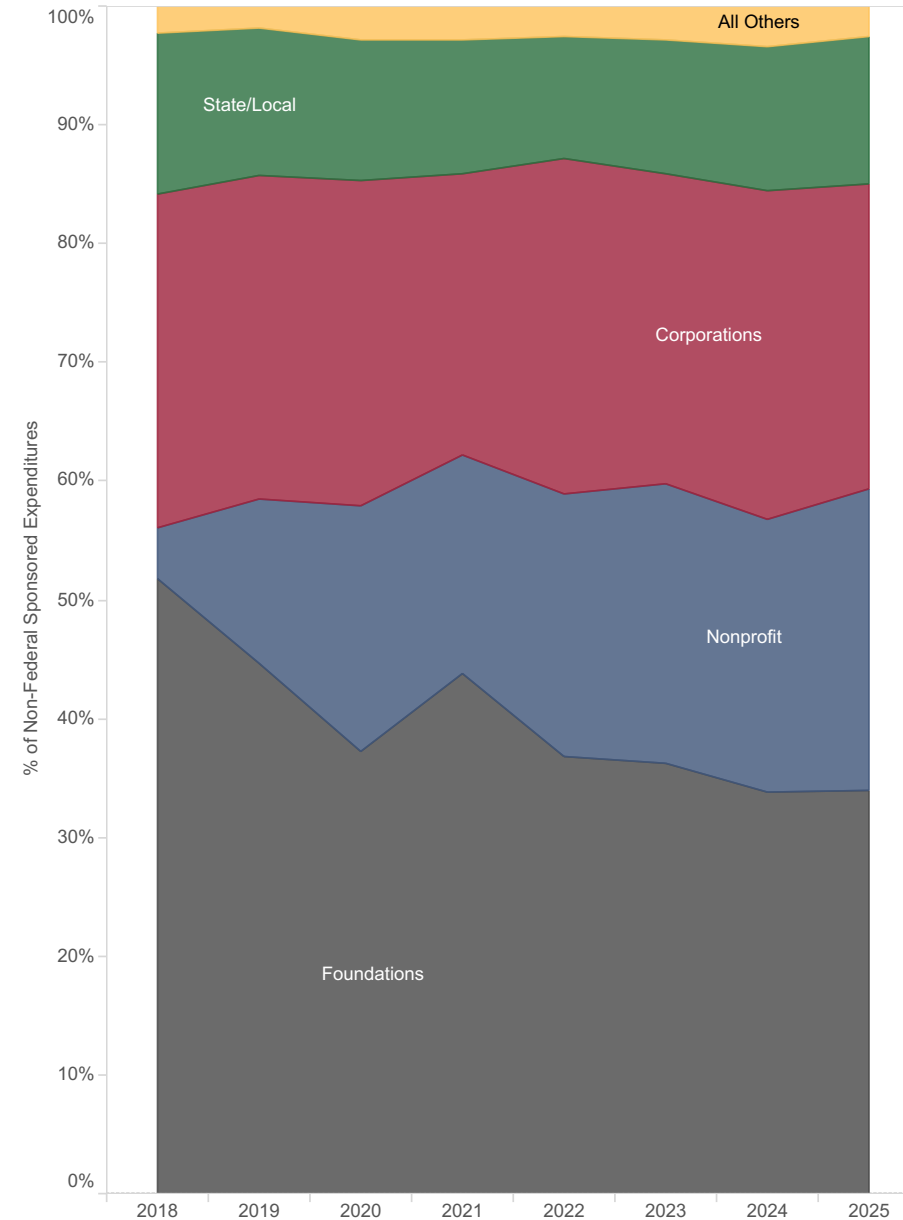

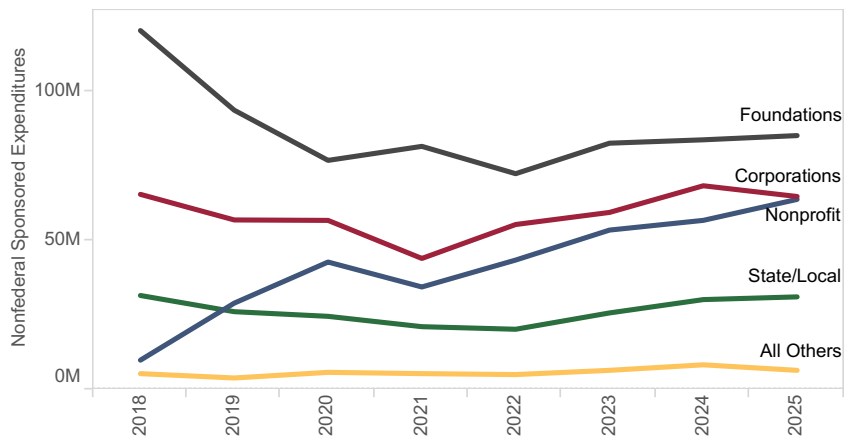

Nonfederal Sponsored Expenditures - Composition by Sponsor Type



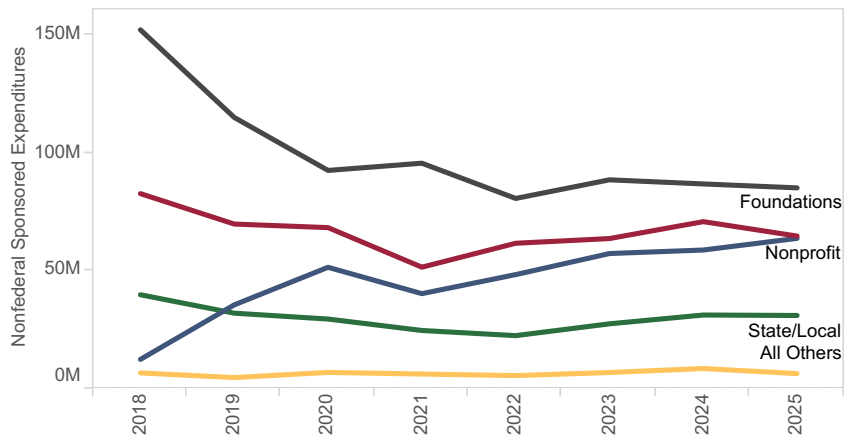

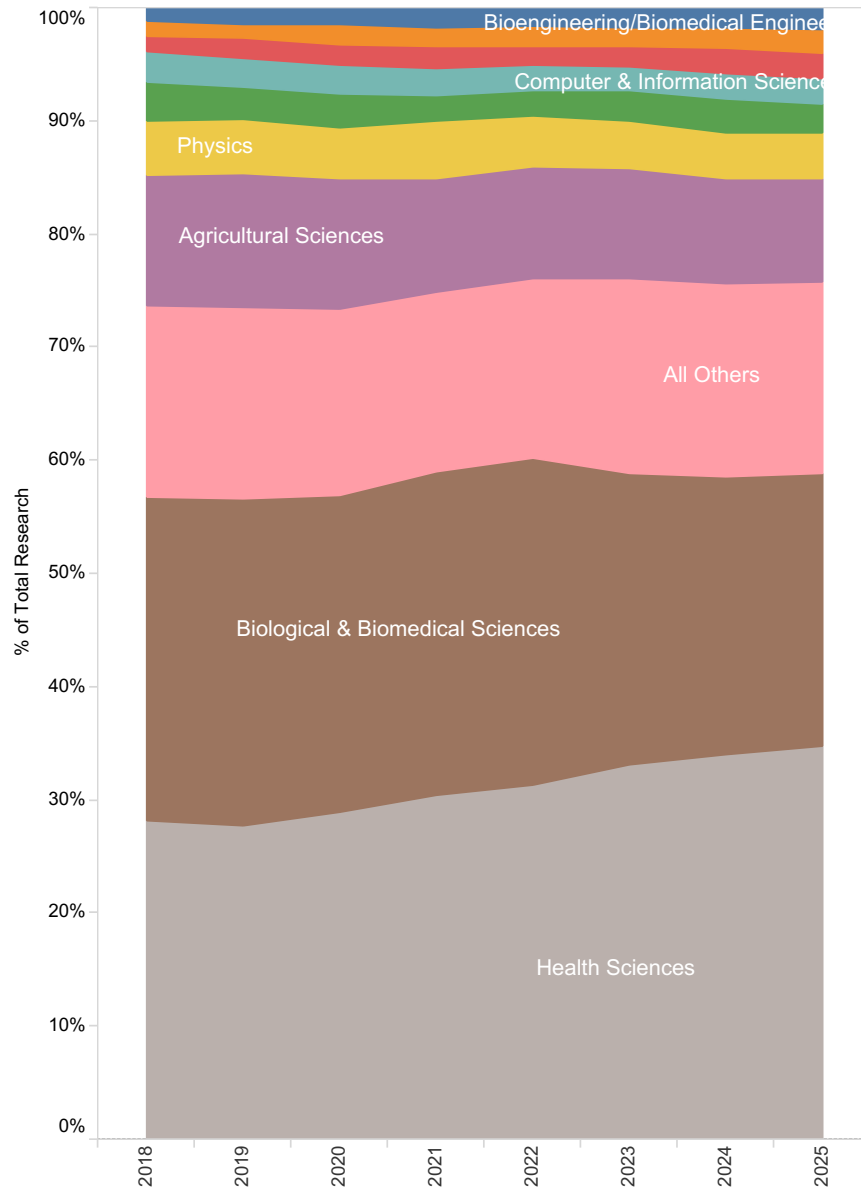

Organized Research Expenditures - Composition by Discipline FY2018 to FY2025

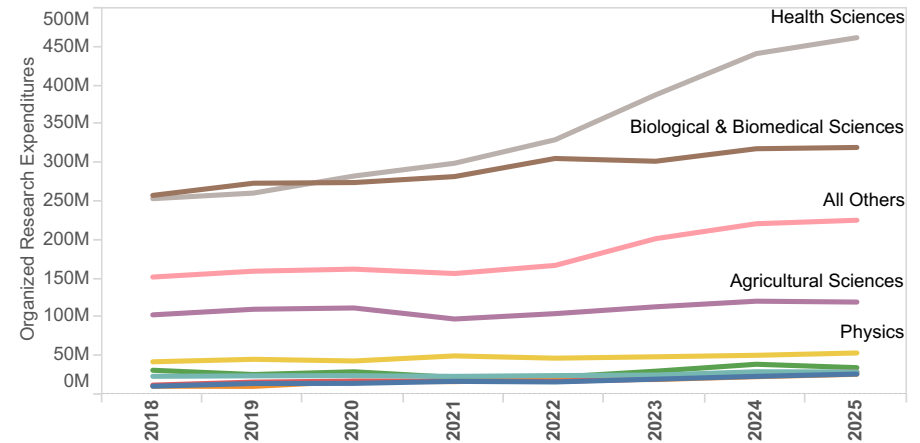


Organized Research by Discipline - FY2018 to FY2025

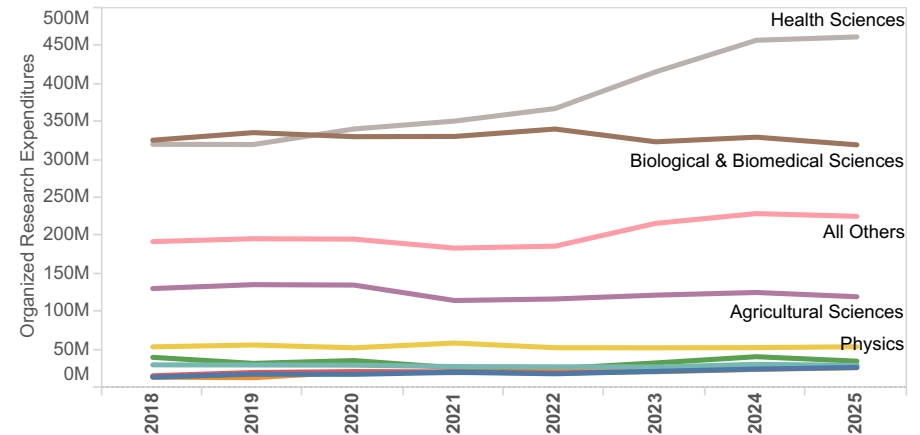
